Are you angry? We are steaming. Last week the province clobbered Halton Hills (and Halton) with three draconian measures:

- Overturned Halton Region's Official Plan Amendments (ROPA 49), now allowing urban expansion on 8000! acres of precious farmland we worked so hard to save here and in Milton. *Will we become the City of Halton Hills?*
- Slashed the Greenbelt
- Announced *Bill 23 – More Homes Built Faster Act* which will destroy Halton Hills' exemplary climate goals, and steal away development charges the town needs.

There's an easy way to vent to the Minister of Housing Steve Clark. **You can leave a short, recorded phone message** for him. Let's send a deluge! Here's how.

1. Jot down two or three simple points you want to make. There's lots of info below to help you.
2. Call Steve Clark's Ministry Office: 416-585-7000. If you reach a real person, simply say you want to leave a message for the Minister. You'll be routed to a machine.
3. Same for his constituency office in Brockville: Toll free 1-800-267-4408
4. In both cases you can review your recorded message before sending it.

You can also call the Premier's office 416-325-1941. You may get a real person. They are very polite.
