THE HAMLET OF GLEN WILLIAMS RESIDENT ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS December 31, 2023

1. PURPOSE OF ORGANIZATION

The Hamlet of Glen Williams Resident Association Incorporated (the "Corporation"), a not-for-profit organization, was incorporated on August 23, 2016 under the Ontario Business Corporations Act as a private Corporation managed by a board. Special provisions of incorporation are such that the Corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the Corporation shall be used in promoting its objects. The objects for which the Corporation is incorporated are to advance the cultural and social interest of the residents of properties in and around The Hamlet of Glen Williams in the Province of Ontario, carry on research and investigation into problems connected with the ownership and development of property in The Hamlet of Glen Williams, and promote aquatic, athletic, social and cultural activities among the residents of said area and such other complementary purposes not inconsistent with these objects.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations and are in accordance with Part III of Canadian generally accepted accounting principles, and reflect the following policies:

- a) Revenue and expenses are recorded on an accrual basis.
- b) Contributions are recorded under the deferral method of accounting.
- c) Contributed materials and services are measured at fair value at the date of contribution.
