- Update GWCA October 2023 Traffic Report

  - Conduct a second resident survey
  - o Hold one open resident meeting re: preliminary findings
  - o Finalize the updated traffic report and begin draft of implementation plan
  - Seek Town of Halton Hills staff and Council input
- Continue on-going dialogue with the Town of Halton Hills
  - Propose to the Town and Council a protocol for improved consultation in order to influence town initiatives
  - Continue regular dialogue relating to parking, signage, through-traffic, Town of Halton Hills Traffic Reports from 2023 and 2024 and all other traffic matters as appropriate

### **PARKS & TRAILS**

## **Objectives**

- Work with Town of Halton Hills staff to ensure park areas and trails are maintained and are a recognized and important part of any developments in Glen Williams
- Partner with Town of Halton Hills Parks and Recreation Department to determine vision of parks and trails in Glen Williams to meet resident's current and future needs
- Consult with Credit Valley Conversation and other groups about trail initiatives and Credit River stewardship opportunities for the Glen
- Educate members about park, trail and river issues and promote activities through the newsletter and other formats

- Continue as Stewards of the Shelagh Law Parkette
  - Spring clean up of gardens
  - Replace for any winter loss
  - · Continue to maintain gardens in Parkette ongoing
- Partner with Credit Valley Conservation for an invasive species removal project at Shelagh Law Parkette – Fall
- Continue to advocate for preservation of existing informal trails connecting Bishop Court and The Field to the core hamlet and development of more connected trail systems in the Glen, specifically the proposed Town of Halton Hills trail system behind 102 Confederation St. development and Bishop Court

# **Objectives**

- Act as stewards of the Glen Williams Secondary Plan (GWSP)
- Help residents understand all components of GWSP
- Liaise with residents about proposed or on-going development projects and communicate potential impacts to residents and landscape and character of the Glen
- Engage with the Town of Halton Hills staff and Developers in all aspects of the planning and development process for designated developments, ensuring the GWSP is adhered to

  - Continue to monitor activity, engaging with Town staff and Charleston Homes as required
  - Continue to monitor activity, and actively work with Town and Developer following progress on conditions of approval and following on identified GWCA issues lists ensuring alignment with GWSP and continued well being and quality of life for current residents
- The Field Property 159 Confederation St.
  - Continue to review activity related to first submission by Developer, Eden Oak. Engage with stakeholder(s) as required, opposing application as filed, advocating for alignment with Glen Williams Secondary Plan and continued well being and quality of life for current residents.
    File as Participant should Developer appeal to Ontario Land Tribunal.
- The Chase Development (Developer Eden Oak)
  - Monitor remaining activities and respond to any issues arising from final construction phase. Pedestrian path up to rail trail still not open
- Committee of Adjustment:
  - Monitor monthly agendas and respond as required when variance requests filed by developers for Glen developments do not appear to be in alignment with approved plans or GWSP
