- **Updates**
 - Development Committee:
 - **159 Confederation** - The Field update: The Development Committee completed a first review of all reports submitted by the Developer. The committee drafted a detailed issues list that will be sent to Town staff. Committee met with Town staff March 4 to discuss issues. Committee met with Lawyer and retained Planner to discuss approach for presentation to Town Council on March 24. More than 120 letters of opposition submitted by residents. The chamber was full of residents for the March 24 Council meeting with approx. 50 on Zoom as well. Impactful presence. A handful of residents also presented/spoke. All effective in delivery of key issues. Mayor commented at the end of session how impressed she was that all speakers were professional and succinct in their delivery.  - **Parks & Trails:**
 - Discussion about partnering with Credit Valley Conservation for an invasive plant removal project. Board in agreement and date of May 25 2025 chosen.
 - **Traffic & Safety:** Roger Parking, tourist destination
 - **Glen200:** updates of Glen200 events provided by Mike and Joan. St. Patrick's Dinner and Dance a great success. 200 Native Tree Sale launched. Next up events include The Hobby Horse custom quilt raffle – Canadian Maple, Sunday, May 4 confirmed for the Bruce Trail Youth Hike. Saturday, June 14th is the Glen Williams Cemetery annual service followed by an open Glen reunion at St. Alban Church Hall. Still looking for volunteers to help on the Working Group and on Sept. 27 and still looking for corporate sponsors to help fund all events.
